MiP is the UK's only trade union organisation specifically for managers in health services. MiP was launched in 2005 as a joint venture by [Unison](#) [1], the largest public service union, and [FDA](#) [2], the specialist management union. It was set up to provide trade union representation tailored to the needs of managers in healthcare.

MiP has nearly 6,000 members throughout the UK, working in the NHS, the private and third sector. The MiP membership profile reflects that of management in the health services and 54% of members are women. Our members play a key role in promoting equality and diversity and tackling discrimination in service delivery and employment practices.
